# **Reversing and directing**

Reversing is the most dangerous movement of vehicles! Instructions can prevent accidents.

#### When reversing the driver should:

• drive at walking speed

If there is a risk of injuring somebody you need to be directed and observe the following:

- be familiar with the hand signals of the directing person (see tip 1)
- stop the vehicle immediately if you no longer see the directing person

#### To assist the driver, the directing person ensures:


- being within sight area driver and wearing a high-visibility jacket
- mastering hand signals
- not to walk backwards
- not engaging in other activities whilst directing, e.g. mobile phone use

### Tip 1:

Coordinate all hand signals with the directing person beforehand.


## Attention:

If you no longer see the directing person: stop immediately!



# **Reversing and directing**

Directing can only succeed if both the driver and the directing person interpret signs the same. Your alphabet - the most important signs:



### Note:

We have established the following rules for reversing and directing:

## Tip 2:

The images above show what you see in the rear-view mirror – thus shown mirror-inverted. Whether right or left: Drive to where the person is directing you.
